



SCHOLARSHIPS, FELLOWSHIPS, AND AWARDS FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS ENTERING FALL 2024

Scholarships are awarded based on academic information, student interest, student leadership and/or talent. In instances where a student qualifies for more than one scholarship, the student will receive the largest scholarship for which they are eligible.

In cases where students are eligible to receive more than one award, the total cannot exceed tuition and fees.

Chapel Fellowship	Awarded to one student with experience and interest in leading music worship	\$2,500 per year	Must maintain 2.0 GPA.
Church & College Fellowship	Active members of the Presbyterian Church (USA) or the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. Recipients are committed to providing three hours per week of volunteer service to local Presbyterian churches.	\$2,000 per year	Must maintain 2.0 GPA.
ALANA Cultural Diversity Award	Students who identify as African American, Lantinx, Asian and Native American. Recipients work to become stronger allies advocate for justice, diversity, inclusion, and equity at Maryville College.	Up to \$2,000 per year	Must maintain 2.0 GPA.
Instrumental Music Ensemble Award	Non-music majors based on individual talent, merit, and ensemble. Recipients required to participate in a related music ensemble(s).	Up to \$2,000 per year/ensemble	Must maintain 2.5 GPA per semester AND must continue involvement in music ensemble.
Choral Award	Non-music majors. Prefer at least two years prior participation in a high school chorus. Recipients required to participate in a choral ensemble(s).	Up to \$2,000 per year	Must maintain 2.5 GPA and must continue involvement in a choral ensemble.
Equestrian Scholarship	Equestrians riding/showing for a minimum of three years preferably at three-foot fences or higher.	\$2,000 per year	Must maintain 2.75 GPA
MC Playhouse Award	Non-theatre majors. Prefer at least two years of prior participation in theatre productions. Recipients are required to participate in theatre productions.	Up to \$2,000 per year	Must maintain 2.5 GPA and must continue involvement in theatre productions.
Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship	Awarded to potential student leaders. Candidates must be members of Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society and have a 3.5 cumulative GPA.	\$1,000 per year	Must maintain 2.5 GPA
MC First Award	Students from families where their parents/guardians did not complete a four-year college degree.	\$1,000 per year	
MC Alumni Award	Students whose parent, grandparent, aunt, uncle, or sibling graduated from Maryville College. Graduates will be verified by Alumni Office.	\$1,000 per year	
Educator Award	Students whose parent or guardian is a current K-12 teacher in a public or private school in the United States.	\$1,000 per year
